

DRESS CODE

Clients must wear clothing that is appropriate for their adherence to the treatment and therapeutic philosophy of Westover Treatment Centre. The following minimum standards apply:

WE ARE A CO-ED. FACILITY. STAFF WILL HAVE THE FINAL DECISION ON THE APPROPRIATNESS OF ATTIRE

- 1. No shirts with distracting / distasteful slogans or pictures. Shirts **must** have sleeves. **NO THIN STRAP TANK TOPS OR MUSCLE SHIRTS.** Sweat shirts, sweaters and hoody's are acceptable.
- 2. Pants, jeans and track pants are acceptable. Pants must be pulled up appropriately at all times. Tight fitting clothing without some kind of covering (e.g. shirt, sweater) is not considered appropriate.
- 3. No pyjamas or pyjama pants on the main floor.
- 4. No bathing suits, short-shorts, or mini-skirts are to be worn at any time.
- 5. Casual or running shoes (no bedroom slippers on main floor).
- 6. Due to allergies and sensitivity that some people have to scents, Westover strives to be a scent free facility. Unscented personal care products are encouraged. Perfume, cologne and other fragrances are contraband items.
- 7. No Hats or hoods are to be worn inside any of the buildings.
